### Olympic League:

#### **Each Parent shall:**

- a. abide by the OLQP Sports Committee Mission Statement, Objectives and Expectations.

### CYO:

#### **Each Parent shall:**

- a. abide by the CYO Code of Ethics as follows:
  - ~To emphasize the proper ideals of sportsmanship, ethical conduct and fair play.
  - ~To stress the values derived from being fair.
  - ~To show cordial courtesy to opponents and officials.
  - ~To establish a happy relationship between visitors and hosts.
  - ~To respect the integrity and judgment of officials.
  - ~To achieve a thorough understanding and acceptance of the rules and standards of eligibility.
  - ~To encourage leadership, use of initiative and good judgment by the players.
  - ~To recognize that the purpose of competitions is to promote the physical, mental, moral, social and emotional well-being of the players.
  - ~To remember that a contest is only an activity and not a matter of life or death for player, coach, school, parish, official and fan.
- b. understand that if their child is a CYO player, they must participate in Olympic League and failure to do so may result in suspension from CYO.
- c. understand they are responsible to fulfill two Team Night obligations during the course of the season and failure to do so will result in suspension of their child from the Team until that obligation has been fulfilled, unless that have made prior arrangements with the CYO Coordinator .
